* The only polling location in Carson City will be at the Community Center Gymnasium at 851 E William Street for early and election day voting in person.

* To Vote in Carson City, you have 3 options: mail your ballot, drop off your ballot or vote in person.

* You may hand deliver mail-in-ballots to the Community Center or the Senior Center at 911 Beverly Dr. during specific times. Please check the Clerk Recorder's website or call their office to determine which day and times the secure drop box is available for accepting your ballots. The Clerk Recorder's Drop Boxes have observers and ballots and are collected every day.

* Every registered voter will receive a Mail-in-Ballot. You may OPT out of receiving a ballot by mail by filling out a form and returning to the Clerk Recorder's office by September 9 for this election cycle. You may drop off your ballot or Vote in Person.

* Military Ballots and Out of State Ballots will be mailed out the week of Sep 29, 2022.

* Sample Ballots are mailed out on Oct 7, 2022.

* In-State Mail-in-ballots mailed 19 Oct 2022.

* Early Voting Starts Saturday October 22 to November 4.

* Drop Box available at the Carson City Senior Center at 911 Beverly Drive, check for availability with the Clerk Recorder's Office

* Election Day 8 Nov, 2022 Voting in person Community Center Gymnasium 851 E William Street Carson City.

* NOV 17, 2022 The Carson City Clerk Recorder shall conduct post-election VVPAT Audit and transmit the results to the Secretary of State

Ballot Initiatives

Question 1: ERA. Vote NO.

Establishes transgender as a protected class. Would allow transgender individuals into girls' bathrooms and showers, and to compete in girls' sports.

Question 2: \$15 minimum wage. Vote NO.

Wage rates should adapt to the circumstances in each part of the state. Supply and Demand should determine the price of labor.

Question 3: Ranked Choice Voting. Vote NO.

Establishes open primaries: any voter can vote for any candidate. Could result in only Democrats on the ballot in the general election.
