

2024 Nevada Republican Caucus

General Agenda

5:00 PM – Voter registration opens

- Voter eligibility is verified and voter is checked in.
- Voter is given Preference Poll ballot and directed to specific caucus location.

5:30-6:00 PM (Approximately) – Precinct meeting called to order

- Once all voters are signed in, precinct meeting will be called to order (Voters may join the precinct meeting at any time if they arrive late)
- Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance
- Election of precinct caucus chair and secretary
- Welcome letters from State and County party chairs
- Nomination of delegates and alternate delegates to County Conventions
- Election of County Convention delegates and alternates, if necessary
- Submission and consideration of 2024 GOP Platform planks – attendees are encouraged to submit planks that they feel are important
- Submission of Resolutions for consideration at the county convention
- Attendees will be given the opportunity to speak in favor of their favored candidate (No attendee is ever required to publicly express their support for a candidate)
- Miscellaneous county party business – i.e., accept nominations for county central committee members
- Balloting to Presidential Preference by secret written ballot

7:30 PM (Earliest) – Counting and tabulation of Presidential Preference Poll ballots

- Final item of business for the precinct meeting and deadline for Drop and Go balloting
- All meeting attendees are encouraged to participate in and/or observe the count, which will not begin before 7:30 pm.
- If business has not been completed by 7:30 PM, the precinct meeting will continue until all business is completed.
- When ballot counting is complete, vote totals will be announced to all attendees, and reported to the county central committee who will in turn report them to the Nevada GOP.
